Chancellor's Diversity Award 2009

Purpose of Award:

The award is to publicly acknowledge, recognize and honor a law firm, legal organization or individual who has made a substantial contribution to diversity and inclusion in the legal field. Nominations for the award are accepted from any member of the Philadelphia Bar Association

Criteria:

Potential awardees may be an individual attorney, law firm of any size, legal services organization, or law school. The nominee(s) must practice in Philadelphia and should demonstrate a sustained and continuous appreciation of and contribution to diversity and inclusion in the field. However, nominations will be accepted for a single contribution that may be considered outstanding.

If the nomination is for a law firm, law school or organization, it may include an outstanding or innovative programmatic activity that has either highlighted diversity, increased diverse representation or supported inclusion efforts in the legal field. These activity(ies) should support the areas of commitment to diversity mentioned in the Philadelphia Bar Association's Statement of Diversity Principles.

If the nomination is for an individual, she or he must have a history of demonstrated and sustained commitment to the tenets of diversity through activity(ties) that support the areas mentioned in the Philadelphia Bar Association's Statement of Diversity Principles.

Nomination Process:

Complete the nomination packet and return to the Philadelphia Bar Association by **5:00 pm on October 23, 2009**. Nomination materials may be found at <http://www.philabar.org>.

The Chancellor's Diversity Award will be formally presented at the Philadelphia Bar Association's Annual Meeting on **December 8, 2009**.
