Every year, seven new members are elected to serve three-year terms on the YLD Executive Committee. This year's Election will take place on December 7, 2010 in conjunction with the Philadelphia Bar Association's Annual Meeting. **A Nominating Petition and Personal Statement is enclosed.** Any Voting Member of the Division shall be eligible for election to the 2011 Executive Committee provided that the term of office for which the individual runs shall not extend beyond his or her membership in the Division. You are eligible if you are 37 years of age or less in the year 2013, or if you are older than 37, you will not be celebrating more than your third year of practice in 2013. **The Nominating Petition and Personal Statement must be returned** to the offices of the Philadelphia Bar Association, 1101 Market Street, Eleventh Floor, **no later than 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 6, 2010.**

Please join us at **5:00pm that same day** for an information meeting and ballot position drawing at the Bar Association headquarters in the 10th Floor Board Room.

The Executive Committee manages and directs the business and activities of the YLD's approximate 3,000 members, including oversight of more than 30 committees in the areas of public service, law-related education and service to the legal community.
