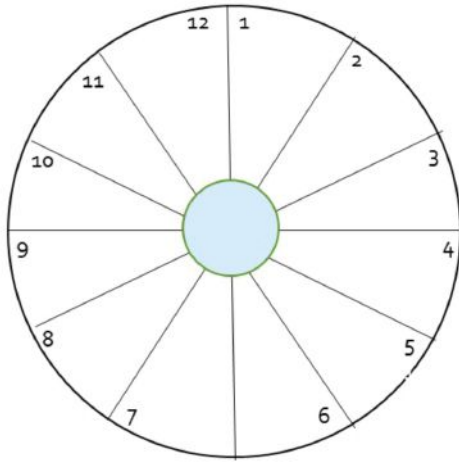


# BOB STERN'S CIRCLE PUZZLE



For this puzzle, place one word (or part of compound word) in each box. The adjacent boxes will form a two-word phrase or compound word. For example, if the clue for boxes 1–2 was “Lawyer representing the state in prosecuting criminal cases,” the answer would be “Attorney General.” “Attorney” would go in box 1 and “General” in box 2. If the clue for boxes 2–3 was “Bailed-out American automobile company,” the answer would be “General Motors.” The word “General” is already in box 2; you insert the word “Motors” in box 3; and so on. Good luck!
